SUSPENSION ORDER

On this day, the matter of Faye Yeager Taylor (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 241076 and resides in Texas.
2. Effective on or about December 11, 2011, the Respondent’s producer license in her home state is no longer active.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

3. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
4. In order to obtain a nonresident producer license in Arkansas, Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-508(a)(1) requires that the person be licensed as a resident and in good standing in his or her home state.

5. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-508(b), the Commissioner has the authority to summarily suspend a nonresident producer whose domiciliary state has suspended, revoked, or otherwise terminated his or her resident producer license.

6. Upon presentation of sufficient evidence that a nonresident producer's home state license is active and in good standing, the suspension under this order shall be lifted as a matter of law pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-508(b)(3).

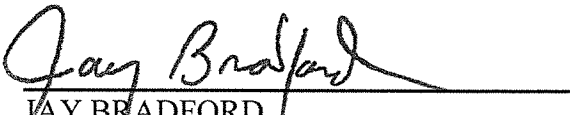
7. Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 241076 is immediately and summarily suspended.

8. Respondent is instructed that she may request an administrative hearing regarding this matter within thirty (30) days of the date of this Suspension Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 241076 is hereby **SUSPENDED**. Respondent shall not, during the term of this suspension, conduct the business of insurance in the State of Arkansas.
