FIRE MARSHAL'S REPORT

Arkansas' fire record for 1935 is such as to afford considerable gratification. Fire losses on insured property were smaller last year than in any previous year since 1918. In 1935 the stock fire companies collected in premiums a total of \$6,223,522; the net losses paid by them during the year amounted to \$2,166,743. The 34.82% loss ratio thus established represents an all-time low, as is indicated by the experience table given on Page 14 of this report. If the experience of the companies is as favorable in 1936 as it was in 1935—if they collect as much in premiums and pay out no more in losses—there is good reason to hope that underwriting profits will justify and bring about a reduction in insurance rates.

Several factors have contributed to the improvement that has been made in the State's fire record in the past two years. Better care in matters of fire prevention, for one thing; better efficiency on the part of fire departments in the cities and towns over the State, for another; but most of all, better underwriting on the part of insurance agents over the State. Unquestionably, the last factor has had a great deal of weight. Continued caution is urged upon fire insurance agents, in the assumption of risks and in the valuation of properties for insurance, to the end that over-insurance and the temptations that go with it may be done away with.

Some few of the suspicious fires reported to this Department during 1935 involved insured property; but for

the most part such suspicious fires involved property not insured. The usual number of supposedly "spite" fires was reported—fires involving such structures as barns, rural dwellings, cotton gins, churches and schools. The isolation of such properties and the secrecy and furtiveness with which they are set makes it difficult to fix the responsibility for them.

Investigations participated in by this Department last year resulted in the indictment and conviction of several persons for arson. Other indictments and convictions were obtained by local officers over the State. All signs indicate that the people of Arkansas have awakened to the menace of incendiarism and that they are anxious to stamp it out. Sheriffs, prosecuting attorneys, fire chiefs and police officers have shown a willingness to cooperate with this Department and with the general public in putting the firebug out of business.

The improvement that has been made in the past two years encourages the hope that the time is not distant when Arkansas will have a fire record which will favorably compare with that of any State of the Union similarly populated. When this time arrives, insurance rates are bound to come down.
