





Dear Governor:

I have the honor to submit the fifty-ninth annual report of the State Insurance Department containing the activities of this Department for the preceding year, together with comments and recommendations. This report includes the condensed financial statements, together with business transacted in Arkansas, of all insurance companies, foreign and domestic, which were authorized to transact business in the State during the year 1939.

REDUCTION OF FIRE INSURANCE RATES

You will recall that in 1938 a rate reduction in fire insurance premiums was ordered amounting to \$878,643.13. This order was based on the underwriting profit, in excess of five per cent, made by the stock fire insurance companies on Arkansas business for the five year period, 1933-1937, inclusive. All of this reduction was given to residential property.

In 1939 the second rate reduction was ordered based on the underwriting profit for the five year period, 1934-1938, inclusive. This underwriting profit, in excess of the five per cent, amounted to the sum of \$1,333,678.36 and after crediting the companies with part of the previous reduction still applicable the Department found from the experience by classes that this rate reduction should be allowed as follows:

1. Mercantile and office buildings, 10% reduction.
2. Stock and contents, 5% reduction.
3. Miscellaneous classes, 10% to 20% reduction.

The tabulation for the five year period 1935-1939, inclusive, discloses the fact that for the third straight year the companies have made an underwriting profit, according to the three last five year periods, over the five per cent allowed by law. The reduction based on the present five year period has been taken care of by the credits allowed the companies on that part of the two previous reductions still applicable, plus the following reductions which have gone into effect:

1. Sixteen cities and towns in Arkansas have been re-rated, since April 1, 1939, on account of improvements in fire departments and water supply. This item shows an annual reduction in premiums of \$33,041.00, or \$165,205.00 for the five year period.
2. Reductions were made on cotton compresses and cotton during 1939 amounting to \$76,940.63 annually, or \$384,703.15 for the five year period.

These two reductions together with the reductions put into effect by the orders of 1938 and 1939 show a savings to our citizens carrying fire insurance of \$1,777,620.39.

The loss ratios during the past few years have decreased. Due to the hearty cooperation of the citizens of this State in fire prevention work, the wholehearted assistance of all peace officers and the untiring efforts of the Fire Marshal's Division in running down arsonists and carrying a campaign of education on fire prevention to all parts of the State, these lower loss ratios have been made possible. Continued vigilance will bring about further rate reductions.

The 1939 legislature gave the Fire Marshal an assistant and the wisdom of this move is reflected in the additional convictions in arson cases. We recommend that another assistant be added by the 1941 legislature.

FIRE MARSHAL'S DIVISION

During the year 1939 the Fire Marshal has investigated all types of fires in all sections of the State. We also inspected a large number of public buildings, including schools, dormitories and theatres. The large number of school fires during 1939 is indeed alarming, there being some thirty-five school buildings destroyed during the year. There were some ten theatre fires during the latter part of the year with an approximate \$100,000 loss. We are indeed thankful that no lives were lost in these school and theatre fires. Many of the school fires were caused by defective flues, over-heated furnaces, etc, and in several instances, it is our opinion, where school buildings were burned just before completion, the fires were set in order to stimulate employment. We should like very much to see all school buildings made fire-proof or as nearly so as possible.

We have been able, with the assistance of Mr. C. Kramer Roberts since August 1st, to investigate more fires and to give those we did investigate more attention. A great deal of time has been spent in the investigation of automobile fires, the results of which will appear in the 1940 report as most of these cases were passed for trial until 1940.

The Fire Marshal and his Assistant have traveled 49,172 miles and investigated 101 cases during the year. Twenty confessions and sixteen convictions have been procured. To date, since January 1, 1940, we have filed or procured indictments in twenty-six cases and obtained fourteen confessions and twelve convictions. We now have

cases pending against some twenty or twenty-five persons on informations filed this year and last year. In fact the Grand Jury and trial work is now occupying a considerable portion of our time.

At first our work was largely pioneering and missionary work, but since we have gone about the State so frequently, the public has become educated to fire prevention and the law enforcement agencies are unanimous in their desire to suppress arson in order that the lives and property of the people may be properly protected.

CONCLUSION

The drive against unauthorized insurance has been successful. The people of Arkansas have awakened to the fact that insurance companies who do not wish to comply with our laws usually find excuses for not paying claims. We wish to thank the newspapers and the radio stations for their voluntary and hearty assistance in this fight.

The Department appreciates your full cooperation in every phase of its duties and I wish to assure you of our continued efforts on behalf of our people.
