Dear Governor:

I am pleased to submit to you the sixty-first annual report of the State Insurance Department, giving information as to the activities of this Department for the preceding year. This report gives a condensed financial statement of business transacted by all insurance companies, foreign and domestic, authorized to transact business in this State during the year 1941.

COLLECTIONS

The collections of this Department from January 1, 1941, to December 31, 1941, inclusive, were \$749,151.69. This amount was according to law deposited to the credit of the following accounts in the State Treasury:

General Fund \$584,334.64; Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund \$46,012.72; Sanitation Fund of the State Board of Health \$75,967.23; Workmen's Compensation Fund \$42,-837.10. The increase over the previous year's collections totals \$46,763.63.

WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

The Workmen's Compensation Law which became effective December 1, 1940, caused the entry to the State of several companies which heretofore were not authorized to transact business in Arkansas. Altogether 50 companies have qualified to write Workmen's Compensation Insurance, and each paid the \$500.00 initial qualifying fee as required by law. We have made an earnest effort to see that just rates are set up that will not be discriminatory either to the insured or to the insurer. Since this class of insurance is new in Arkansas, we have no past experience to guide us, therefore, we have had to use the experience tables of other states where the conditions are similar to ours. We have done our best to correct rate inequalities

from time to time during the year. Other adjustments will be made when and as quickly as our own State's experience is established.

REDUCTION OF FIRE INSURANCE RATES

Reductions in fire insurance rates were ordered by this Department in both years, 1938 and 1939. The fire underwriting profit report is made on a five year basis. All reductions in rates were spread over a five year period or one-fifth of the amount applied each year. As a result of the reduction of rates previously ordered by this Department as stated above, the amount of savings to policy-holders during the year, 1941, was \$293,699.08, applied as follows: \$209,284.08 to dwellings in cities and towns; \$84,415.00 to mercantile and office buildings, garages and dry cleaning plants and contents, also lumber, forest products in sheds and on yards, and paper mills; plus the following annual reductions which were made effective 1939 by the Arkansas Fire Prevention Bureau with the approval of this Department; sixteen re-rated towns, annual reduction, \$33,041.11; cotton and cotton compresses, annual reduction, \$76,940.63; public buildings, fire proof and sprinkler risks, annual reduction, \$73,982.00; which makes a grand total reduction of policy-holders of Arkansas for the year 1941 of \$477,662.71.

The above sum total reductions will continue in force during the year 1942.

FIRE MARSHAL'S DIVISION

During the year 1941, the Fire Marshal's Division has investigated 102 arson cases in all sections of the State. The Fire Marshal and his Deputy have traveled approximately 43,967 miles at a total cost to the State of Arkansas of \$2,-825.48. Twenty-seven persons have been convicted of arson at the instance of the Fire Marshal's Division, seventeen of which were for the destruction of buildings and improvements on real estate, and ten were for the destruction of automobiles. The State Fire Marshal has handled all the investigations of burning of buildings and the Deputy Fire Marshal handled all the investigations of automobile fires. In addition to the above there are nine cases of arson now pending in the Circuit Courts throughout the State.

It is regretted that there has been a marked increase in the number of public school fires of 1941. In some of the cases it appears that the fires were of incendiary

origin while others were apparently from carelessness and thoughtlessness on the part of those who were charged with wiring, and the installation of heating plants, and those charged with janitor service in the schools.

The Fire Marshal has done some educational work and has devoted some time to the duties of the State Fire Defense Council in assisting Mr. H. T. Buchanan and the other regional co-ordinators throughout the State.

It is the opinion of the Fire Marshal that this Division could become more effective if the facilities for fire prevention work were increased and a larger part of the time devoted to educational work.

For the duration of the war it will be the intent of the Fire Marshal's Division to answer all requests for investigation of sabotage or subversive activities so that not only our homes but all our natural resources will have as much protection against fire as this office can give.

FIRE DEFENSE

At your suggestion, the Honorable Ben H. Wooten, Chairman of the state Defense Council, designated the writer as Coordinator, Citizens Defense Corps, in the early part of 1941. Immediately upon my appointment, I began holding conferences with various interested groups and as a result of these conferences a very comprehensive citizens defense plan has been set up which we believe will function very efficiently for the protection of the people of Arkansas in any emergency that might arise.

Among my assistant Coordinators are Mr. H. T. Buchanan, Chief Engineer Arkansas Fire Prevention Bureau, and Mr. H. A. "Hank" Ritgerod, Acting Director, Arkansas Municipal League. These men are devoting a major part of their time to defense efforts with telling results in every section of Arkansas, and I am greatly indebted to them for the success of the program.

In view of the many national defense industries located in Arkansas we know that our State is vulnerable to attack, and, therefore, have worked out a special program whereby our industries shall be properly protected against sabotage and incendiaryism. This Department is working in close cooperation with the State Police and the F. B. I.

CONCLUSION

In keeping with your leadership, this Department is endeavoring to serve courteously and efficiently the citizens of our State. We are continuing to do our utmost to protect them against "fly-by-night" unauthorized companies who cannot or will not comply with the laws of our State, and we urge all who are in doubt as to the stability of any insurance company to contact this Department for information before putting any money or trust in any insurance company that they are not sure is safe and reliable.

The Department appreciates your cooperation in every phase of its work, and wishes to assure you of our continued efforts to serve well the people of Arkansas.
