My Dear Governor:

I am pleased to submit to you the Sixty-Seventh Annual Report of the State Insurance Department, giving information and statistics as to the activity of this Department for the preceding calendar year 1947. This report gives a condensed financial statement of the business transacted by all insurance companies, foreign and domestic, authorized to transact business in the State of Arkansas during the year 1947.

#### Collection

The amount collected by this Department in taxes and fees during the period for which this report is submitted was \$1,353,422.72. This was paid into the State Treasury as required by law and allocated as follows: General Revenue Fund \$935,425.05; Sanitation Fund \$121,217.95; Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund \$107,233.48; Workmen's Compensation Fund (not including taxes paid by self insurers to the Commission) \$63,479.94. In addition to the above \$70,200.00 in Franchise Tax on insurance companies was paid direct to the State Treasurer by the companies licensed by this Department.

#### Legislation

The 1947 General Assembly passed several Bills affecting the duties and power of the Insurance Department. Act No. 50 and Act No. 116 applying to fire insurance and casualty insurance respectively, gave to this Department supervision of rates and rate making that the Department had not had heretofore. Act 385 requires all taxicabs operating in the State of Arkansas to carry liability insurance in certain amounts, or to give bond to protect the interest of the public.

Other legislation was passed but the three Acts specifically mentioned have increased the work and duties of this Department considerably and has necessitated the

employment of additional personnel. These Acts have been received well by the insurance public and the insurance fraternity and this Department is receiving the cooperation of all in their administration.

### **Fire Insurance**

The fire insurance losses in Arkansas though continuing to remain below the national average, which they have done for the past several years, are definitely on the increase. The loss and expense ratio, as shown elsewhere in this report, for the five year period 1943-1947, inclusive, shows an underwriting profit on the fire insurance business of less than one percent (1%) in excess of the amount permitted by statute. This small amount of excess profit does not justify or warrant an adjustment in fire insurance rates and this is significantly a fact due to the upward trend of fire losses. In 1947 seven cities and towns improved their classification and by so doing the fire rates in these particular cities and towns were reduced approximately \$35,000.00 annually.

### **Workmen's Compensation**

The premium income for Workmen's Compensation Insurance discloses a substantial increase over 1946. This increase is primarily attributed to the industrial development of Arkansas and the construction work that is being performed. The \$5,940,406.00 of Workmen's Compensation premiums in 1947 was almost two million dollars more than was collected in 1946 and was approximately a half million dollars more than was collected in 1944, which was the peak year for Workmen's Compensation Arkansas due primarily to the war industries operating here.

In accordance with the standard countrywide rate making procedure approved by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners, and adopted and approved by Arkansas, Workmen's Compensation rates were reduced an average of 12%, effective June 1, 1948. This average reduction affected the various classifications differently as it has in the past. Some classifications have no changes in rate, some are decreased more than 12% and a slight increase is shown in a few classifications. These classification changes have been based on the experience developed within the individual classifications.

Because of the "escalator" provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Act with respect to benefits pay-

able for disability from silicosis, there has been a 10% increase in the occupational disease element for classifications carrying a specific loading for silicosis and asbestosis.

### Automobiles

In April 1948, the automobile bodily injury and property damage rates for private passenger cars were increased due to the adverse experience as shown by the carriers of this type of insurance. An average increase of 6.4% for bodily injury and 8.9% for property damage was approved applicable to private passenger cars. A 10% rate reduction in the bodily injury rates applicable to commercial motor vehicles was approved at the same time.

Due to the enactment of Act 385 of 1947 requiring taxicabs operating in Arkansas to carry liability insurance, it became necessary for the Insurance Department to form the Arkansas Automobile Assigned Risk Plan. This necessity grew out of the fact that the operators of taxicabs were unable to secure the coverage that the law required them to have. The Arkansas Automobile Assigned Risk Plan is a voluntary plan for granting automobile bodily injury and property damage insurance to risks who are in good faith entitled to insurance coverage but are unable to secure it for themselves.

### Fire Marshal's Division

During the year 1947 arson has shown an increase and the members of the Fire Marshal's Division have been quite active in the investigation of suspicious fires and the inspection of public buildings.

During this period 140 investigations have been made on real and personal property and automobiles. There have been 34 convictions, or confessions, which more than doubles the record of convictions during any like period resulting from investigations cooperated in by this Department. This splendid record of arson investigations and confessions has been made possible by the splendid cooperation of the Fire Marshal's office with the Sheriffs, Prosecuting Attorneys, City Officials, members of the State Police and others who are primarily charged with such duties.

Inspections have been made of 278 buildings. These inspections primarily concern theatres, public and private schools, hotels, child caring institutions, college dormitories, hospitals, night clubs and auditoriums. Many glar-

ing hazards have been found and ordered removed. This division has also cooperated with civic clubs, fire prevention associations, the State Police training school and other organizations in lending its assistance to bringing to the citizens of this state the tremendous loss of lives and property taken as a toll by careless and needless fires.

### Conclusion

In keeping with your leadership this Department is endeavoring to serve efficiently and courteously the citizens of our State. We are also continuing our efforts to do our utmost to protect the citizenship of Arkansas against "fly by night" and unauthorized companies who cannot or will not comply with the insurance laws of our state.

This Department sincerely appreciates your cooperation in every phase of its work and wishes to assure you of our continued efforts to serve well and in a courteous and efficient manner the people of Arkansas.

Massachusetts Protective Life Assurance Company merged with The Paul Revere Life Insurance Company on October 17, 1947, business continued under the latter name.

**Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund Tax**

In accordance with Act 491 of 1921, the Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund Tax has been computed and deposited in the State Treasury. The sum of \$131,783.23 was credited to this fund which, after deducting \$3,953.49 as its pro rata contribution to the General Revenue Fund as provided as Act 311 of 1945 and \$32,829.74 on account of Appropriation Limitations, the full appropriation limit of \$95,000.00 was distributed among the qualified cities and towns.

Since the current appropriation is limited to \$95,000.00 (Section 1, Act 274 of 1947) the balance of \$32,829.74 will be included in the next annual distribution as far as appropriation permits.
