My dear Governor:

I am pleased to submit to you the 69th Annual Report of the State Insurance Department. This report contains a condensed financial statement of all insurance companies authorized in the State of Arkansas and a summary of business transacted by them in this State during the year 1949.

Collections

During the period covered by this report the Department collected in taxes and fees a total of \$1,799,018.77. This was deposited in the State Treasury as required by law and allocated as follows:

General Revenue Fund	\$1,488,986.33
Firemen's Relief & Pension Fund ..	143,226.16
Workmen's Compensation Fund	95,606.28

In addition to the above, insurance companies licensed by this Department paid direct to the State Treasury the sum of \$71,200 in accordance with our franchise tax statute. The operating expense of the Department was \$53,267.42 or 2.96% of our total collections for the year.

Legislation

Several important acts were passed by the 1949 General Assembly affecting the duties and powers of the Insurance Department. Act No. 58 provides for the examination and qualifying of agents and solicitors for fire, casualty and surety insurance companies. Act No. 303, known as the Fair Trades Practices Act, prohibits unfair methods of competition and unfair and deceptive acts and practices in the business of insurance. This legislation further increases the responsibility of the Insurance Commissioner and imposes additional duties upon the Department which we are undertaking to carry out with a small increase in personnel. Act No. 485 of 1949 requiring all taxicabs operating in the State of Arkansas to carry liabil-

ity insurance in certain amounts or to give bond to protect the interests of the public, transferred to the Revenue Department the administrative duties we had been performing during the past two years, under Act No. 385 of 1947. It was agreed by the Revenue Commissioner and myself that better service could be rendered the interested parties by this change without in any way affecting the original purpose of the law.

Act 248 of 1949 defines group life insurance, regulating the writing thereof and provides for standard provisions in group life policies. This is an important piece of legislation since, heretofore, we have had no definite statute on this subject.

License Division

To meet the requirements of Act No. 58 enacted by the 1949 General Assembly, we reorganized our License Division setting up a new system of records and streamlining our procedure to handle the increased volume of work required by this Act. Periodical qualifying examinations are conducted by the Department for applicants applying for fire and casualty agent's license. Fees collected by the License Division were more than the entire operating expense of the Department during 1949.

RATING DIVISION

Workmen's Compensation & Automobile Rates

Rate regulation continues as one of the important functions of the Department. Annual adjustments in workmen's compensation and automobile insurance rates resulted in reductions which, it is estimated, will produce an annual savings of \$325,000 to the citizens of our State. Last November the Department rejected the **mandatory** \$50 deductible clause filed by the Arkansas Inspection and Rating Bureau applicable to hail and windstorm losses. They requested that this filing be substituted for the present form which provides for the payment of the total amount of each loss.

Fire Insurance Rates

Under our rating laws, the fire insurance rates are reviewed annually to determine if an adjustment in rates is indicated. Stock fire insurance companies doing business in this State are allowed under the law an underwriting profit of 5% based on their experience the 5-year period next preceding. If an audit of the 5-year report

submitted by the companies reveals an underwriting profit in excess of 5%, the Commissioner shall have the power to order such reduction in rates as will reduce the underwriting profit on fire insurance business thereafter done to 5%. The loss and expense ratio as shown elsewhere in this report for the 5-year period 1945 to 1949, inclusive, shows an underwriting profit on fire insurance business of 2.93%, totaling \$1,398,903 in excess of the amount permitted by statute. On the basis of this information, we are now making the necessary calculation to effect a proper downward adjustment in rates.

Custodian of Securities

Several domestic life insurance companies keep on deposit in a joint account with this Department approved securities earmarked as reserves for outstanding life insurance policies which bear the certificate of the Insurance Commissioner. On December 31, 1949, these deposits amounted to \$6,886,818.81. In addition, the Department is sole custodian of \$1,373,225 which has been deposited by fifty-two separate companies doing business in this State, said deposits being in lieu of filing statutory bonds. These securities are held in the vault of the State Treasurer in a lock box allocated to this Department. The important detail work incidental to custodianship and maintaining satisfactory records of these securities is ably handled by one of my assistants.

Fire Marshal's Division

This office investigated 123 fires and assisted local law enforcement officials in obtaining 23 convictions for the crime of arson. In addition, the fire marshal directs a full-time program of fire prevention and safety, correlating our efforts with other agencies interested in this important work. We participate regularly in town inspections such as the one recently held at Texarkana when 737 public buildings were surveyed from a fire protection standpoint.

Following your suggestion, this Department in co-operation with the Department of Education inaugurated the Junior Fire Marshal program resulting in the appointment of more than 300 fire marshals and more than 2,000 deputy junior fire marshals who are carrying the message of fire protection to their respective schools. An organized training program is being carried on in these various groups and it is believed that this project will develop into a great property and life saving factor in our State.

Conclusion

The efficiency of the Department and the overall working conditions have been improved by redecorating our main offices and renovating and enlarging our filing and storage facilities. It is our aim to conform to the standards of public service exemplified by your leadership. We sincerely appreciate the cooperation we have had from your office during the past year.
