My dear Governor:

I am pleased to submit to you the 70th Annual Report of the State Insurance Department. This report contains a condensed financial statement of all insurance companies authorized in the State of Arkansas and a summary of business transacted by them in this State during the year 1950.

Collections

During the period covered by this report the Department collected in taxes and fees a total of \$1,997,961.73. This was deposited in the State Treasury as required by law and allocated as follows:

General Revenue	\$1,536,641.38

In addition to the above, insurance companies licensed by this Department paid direct to the State Treasury the sum of \$74,775.00 in accordance with our franchise tax statute. The operating expense of the Department was \$56,203.03 or 2.8% of our total collections for the year.

Legislation

The Department sponsored two bills in the 1951 General Assembly and both were passed without any opposition. Act No. 198 provides for the regulation of Farmers Mutual Aid Associations. Under the original act which was passed in 1897, it was possible for an association to organize and operate for one year without the knowledge of the Insurance Department. The new statute sets out definite requirements and provides that any association

organized in the future must first obtain the approval of the Insurance Commissioner before commencing business. The act also gives the Commissioner supervisory authority over all such companies and associations.

Act No. 394 is the Uniform Individual Accident and Sickness Policy Provisions Law which was approved by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners at its annual meeting in June, 1950. It is believed that this is a forward step toward regulation of this class of business in this State.

Rating Division

The Supreme Court of Arkansas has sustained a ruling of the Commissioner that the Installment Premium Endorsement is a legal filing under our rating law. The Arkansas Inspection & Rating Bureau attacked the filing of the North America Companies in a full scale hearing early in 1950. The Commissioner found in favor of the Companies and the Bureau appealed, first to the Circuit Court of Pulaski County and from there to the higher Court. The opinion, handed down on April 30, 1951, becomes the first case of record in the country on this highly controversial issue.

Custodian of Securities

Several domestic life insurance companies keep on deposit in a joint account with this Department approximately \$8,000,000 in approved securities earmarked as reserves for outstanding life insurance policies which bear the certificate of the Insurance Commissioner. In addition, the Department is sole custodian of approximately \$2,500,000 in approved securities which have been deposited by various insurance companies and pledged as security for the payment of claims.

Fire Marshal's Division

During the period covered by this report, this office, in cooperation with other State and local enforcement officials, have investigated 145 fires and have succeeded in

obtaining 19 convictions of arson with a high number of these investigations still pending.

In carrying out the duties of fire prevention and protection, this office has made 102 specific inspections of places of public assembly and other places constituting fire hazards.

Continuing its work upon the Junior Fire Marshal program which was inaugurated in 1949 at your request, the major school fires showed a decrease from 24 in the fiscal year of 1947-1948 to 4 major school fires in the fiscal year 1950-1951. The four schools having major fires did not participate in the Junior Fire Marshal program. This training program during the past year included nine days of instructions to the Junior Fire Marshals, both white and colored, in various cities throughout the State.

Loss of life by fire decreased from 141 in 1948 to 103 in 1950.

Conclusion

It is the intention of the Insurance Department to conform to the standards of public service exemplified by your leadership. We have continued to improve the service in all Divisions from year to year. The splendid cooperation received from your office during the past year is sincerely appreciated.
