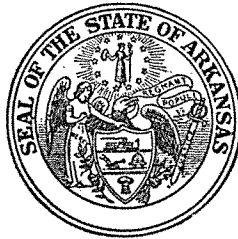

GENERAL REPORT

Collections

During the past year the Department collected in taxes and fees a total of \$2,041,101.58. This was deposited in the State Treasury and allocated by law as follows:

General Revenue	\$1,621,564.21
Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund....	327,397.16
Workmen's Compensation Fund	92,140.21

In addition to the above, insurance companies licensed with this Department paid direct to the State Treasury the sum of \$78,400 in franchise taxes. The operating expense of the Department was \$58,688.19 or 2.8% of our total collections for the year.

Rating Division

The staff handled a steady flow of rate filings and policy forms embracing a wide variety of coverages. Many of the rate problems are national in scope requiring the cooperative effort of all the states in their solution. On a state level, the latest 5-year underwriting experience filed recently by the stock fire insurance companies indicates excess earnings beyond the 5% underwriting profit permitted by law. An order will be issued by this Department in the near future ordering rate reductions as soon as statistical compilations can be completed.

Custodian of Securities

Domestic life insurance companies have on deposit in a joint account with this Department over ten million dollars in approved securities earmarked as reserves for outstanding life insurance policies which bear the certificate of the Insurance Commissioner. In addition, the Department is sole custodian of over \$3,000,000 in approved securities deposited by various insurance companies as security for the payment of claims.

Fire Marshal Division

During the year 1951 this office, in cooperation with other State and local officials, has investigated 137 fires. 17 persons were charged with arson and 11 convictions obtained. The loss of life by fire has increased from 103 in 1950 to 119 in 1951, many of whom died due to careless handling of petroleum products used in the home. Major school fires have decreased from 24 during the fiscal year of 1947-48 to 3 major school fires in the fiscal year of 1951-52.

Fire Prevention

This office is continuing the Junior Fire Marshal program inaugurated in 1949 at your request and we are happy to report that it has gained national recognition for this office. We have assisted in making town inspections, along with 89 inspections of places of public assembly, and the inspection of 29 bulk petroleum storage plants. We have assisted a number of cities in adopting fire prevention ordinances.

Conclusion

The entire personnel of this Department is aware of the importance of its work and makes every effort to do a courteous and efficient job for the citizens of our State. We continue to look for ways to improve the service in all particulars from year to year. It is our aim to conform to the standards of public service exemplified by your Administration.

UNDERWRITING PROFIT REPORT

Each year Stock Fire Insurance Companies are required to make reports as to premiums earned and losses incurred in Arkansas. Figures are compiled showing the results for the five years next preceding the year in which the tabulation is made—see tabulation below:

Under Arkansas Statutes, Section 66-403, the Stock Fire Insurance Companies are allowed a 5% underwriting profit on business done. When this is exceeded the Insurance Commissioner may order such reduction in rates as will reduce the underwriting profit on fire insurance business thereafter done to 5%. Rate reductions have been ordered in 1938, 1944, 1945, 1946, 1950, 1951 and 1952. In the past 20 years dwelling rates have been reduced 50 per cent and substantial reductions made in rates on other classes of occupancy, where the loss experience has been favorable.

FIREMEN'S RELIEF AND PENSION FUND TAX

In accordance with Act 491 of 1921 as amended by Act 488 of 1949, the Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund Tax has been computed and deposited in the State Treasury.

We have drawn a voucher under the authority of Appropriation Act 145 of 1951 for the full 1951 tax less the 3% deduction provided for in Section 2 of Act 114 of 1947 and a further deduction of \$37,819.48 which was necessary due to appropriation limitation. This last amount has been pro rated and credited to the various cities and towns and is available for distribution as soon as the Legislature appropriates the funds. On the following pages you will find a list of the qualified cities and towns, a computation of the Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund Tax showing the net amount payable to each city and town.
