Dear Governor:

I have the honor to submit the Seventy-second Annual Report of the State Insurance Department, as required by law. This report gives information as to the proceedings and activities of the Department for the preceding year. This report also includes the condensed financial statement, together with business transacted in this State, of all insurance companies, foreign and domestic, which were authorized to transact business in the State of Arkansas during the year 1952.

COLLECTIONS

Taxes and fees collected during the period covered by this report amounted to \$2,332,562.38. This was paid into the State Treasury as required by law and allocated as follows:

General Revenue Fund	\$1,807,020.73

In addition to the above, \$83,000.00 in Franchise Tax on Insurance Companies was paid direct to the State Treasurer by the companies licensed by this Department.

CUSTODIAN OF SECURITIES

This department is joint control custodian of approximately \$11,500,000.00 approved securities earmarked as reserves for outstanding life insurance policies of Domestic Life Insurance Companies. In addition, the department is sole custodian of approximately \$3,000,000.00 in approved securities deposited by various companies for the protection of claimants in this state.

FIRE MARSHAL DIVISION

During 1952 this office investigated well over 50 suspicious fires. A number of arson indictments were obtained and a lesser number of convictions. The office cooperated with the Arkansas Inspection and Rating Bureau and Arkansas Fire Prevention Association in town inspections in a number of Arkansas cities. The number of deaths known to have been caused by fires in Arkansas dropped during 1952 from the preceding year from 119 in 1951 to 105 in 1952. Improper handling of kerosene and other petroleum products continued to be an outstanding contributor to Arkansas' losses.

FIRE PREVENTION

The Junior Fire Marshal program inaugurated in 1949 was continued but without as much success as heretofore both in point of results from fires or cooperation of schools. In addition the office has assisted in town inspections and promulgating fire prevention ordinances in a number of instances.

We have now inaugurated a state fire reporting system whereby this office theoretically is to receive a report of every fire which occurs in the state. This will be of invaluable aid in future arson investigations. In addition we are attempting now to enlist the cooperation of the ex-officio deputy Fire Marshals of the state to cut down the amount of work and time consumed in the investigations and at the same time to increase our efficiency. It is our aim to more ardently enforce the existing statutes and regulations regarding fire prevention, and to cooperate in every way with authorized personnel in eliminating fire hazards. It is our fervent hope that our record in this coming year will reflect the standards which I know you desire of your administration.

INSURANCE POLICIES AND RATING DIVISION

In accordance with the duties and powers of the Insurance Department, all policies, forms and rates for all classes of insurance written by authorized companies, have been approved. Under our rating law, the fire insurance rates are reviewed annually to determine if the Stock Fire In-

insurance companies doing business in this state have made an aggregate underwriting profit on fire insurance business in excess of 5% for 5 years next preceding. In 1952, it appears these companies made considerable in excess of 5% and the Insurance Commissioner will exercise the authority granted by Act 163 of 1919 and an order will be issued by this Department in the near future ordering rate reductions as soon as statistical compilations can be completed.

The Insurance Department stands ready to order reductions in rates whenever justified, and if property owners will only cooperate and take proper precautions to prevent fires and if the communities will help by raising their standards of fire protection, we can hope for further reduction of rates in the future.

CONCLUSION

One word of caution to our citizens buying insurance—be sure the Company is admitted to do business in Arkansas. Non-admitted Companies should not be considered. If they are worthy of consideration, they can be admitted and subject themselves to the jurisdiction of our Courts. If these Companies do not care to do this, either their financial structure will not bear inspection or they do not wish to subject themselves to the legal requirements to which other legitimate insurance companies subject themselves.

We wish to thank you for your full cooperation and would welcome any comments and suggestions relative to operation and supervision of the Department.

UNDERWRITING PROFIT REPORT

Each year Stock Fire Insurance Companies are required to make reports as to premiums earned and losses incurred in Arkansas. Figures are compiled showing the results for the five years next preceding the year in which the tabulation is made—see tabulation below:

Under Arkansas Statutes, Section 66-403, the Stock Fire Insurance Companies are allowed a 5% underwriting profit on business done. When this is exceeded the Insurance Commissioner may order such reduction in rates as will reduce the underwriting profit on fire insurance business thereafter done to 5%. Rate reductions have been ordered in 1938, 1944, 1945, 1946, 1950, 1951 and 1952.
